HAON

God of hunters and rangers. Brother of Tor, his symbol is two equal lines crossed at the center.

SOOLTON

God of the sea, sailing and fishing. His symbol is a triangle.

ORBEL

Demigod of truth. His symbol is a bell.

The "Evil" Gods

FEKAR & ERU

God and goddess of evil. They share the same symbol: a black circle.

KLYSS

God of the undead. His symbol is a skeletal human hand.

PUTRYN

Goddess of pain and disease. Her symbol is a randomly-dotted square.

AGORAX

God of chaos. Creator and patron of demons. His symbol is eight arrows, all pointing in different directions, connected at the center.

TOR

God of thieves. Brother of Haon, his symbol is a human foot.

Death and the Afterlife (Druidic)

The deceased's soul is reincarnated until he or she is ready for Paradise.

Druidic Symbols

As Nature, these gods' symbols are abundant everywhere, except in the cities. (And who would want to stay there, anyway?)

The Elder Gods' Names

To non-Druid believers, the gods are known only by ther first three letters of their names, i.e., Zol, Yem, Saz, Bot and Gob. Simple ways for simple people!

Religion

THE GODS OF NATURE (THE ELDER GODS)

As humans built towns and cities and generally moved away from nature, they changed, and so did their values. Druids are clerics who keep alive the old beliefs and deities.

Druids worship all gods equally and as a group.

ZOLIREDONNITKYE

God of the seasons, the sun and the moon.

YEMMENALARALLUREA

Goddess of human life. She gave humans the responsibility to take care of the world.

SAZARWRALLAUNARONE

God of the beasts.

BOTARNADELCHLOROSA

Goddess of plants.

GOBORNURUNSHUMAR

God of water and minerals. Also called "The Protector."
